

"CUTTHROAT TROUT: When working in designated cutthroat trout habitat, disinfect heavy equipment, hand tools, boots and any other equipment that was previously used in a river, lake, pond, or wetland prior to moving to another water body. The disinfection practice should follow this outline:

- Remove all mud and debris from equipment and spray/soak equipment with a 1:15 solution of disinfection solution containing the following ingredients:

- Dialkyl dimethyl ammonium chloride, 5-10% by weight;
- Alkyl dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride, 5-10% by weight;
- Nonyl phenol ethoxylate, 5-10% by weight;
- Sodium sesquicarbonate, 1-5%;
- Ethyl alcohol, 1-5%; and
- Tetrasodium ethylene diaminetetraacetate, 1-5%
- and water, keeping the equipment moist for at least 10 minutes and managing rinse water as a solid waste in accordance with local, county, state, or federal regulations; or
- Spray/soak equipment with water greater than 140 degrees Fahrenheit for at least 10 minutes.
- Sanitize water suction hoses and water transportation tanks (using methods described above) and discard rinse water in an approved disposal facility."
